# CERTIFIED NURSE ASSISTANT TRAINING PROGRAM

## Class Size

A CNA Class consists of only 12 students. These slots are filled on a first come, first served basis. Students should arrive promptly the night of registration with the registration fee.

## CNA RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Work under the supervision of the nursing staff.
2. Answer patients' bell calls
3. Serve meals
4. Make beds
5. Feed, dress, and bathe patients
6. Provide skin care to patients
7. Empty bed pans
8. Change soiled linens
9. Take vital signs
10. Assist patients with walking and getting in and out of bed

## WORKING CONDITIONS

- ♥ Work an average of 40 hour per week
- ♥ May require working evening, weekends, nights and holidays
- ♥ Part-time work may be an option
- ♥ Be prepared to spend many hours standing and walking
- ♥ Take precautionary measures against back injuries



## TRAINING SCHEDULE

1. 8 week class schedule
2. Monday and Thursday nights

3. 88 total program hours
4. 68 classroom hours
5. 20 clinical hours scheduled from  
7:30 a.m. until 2:30 p.m. at an  
approved site.

## JOB OUTLOOK

Employment of nursing assistants is projected to grow 17% from 2014-2024, much faster than the average for all occupations. Because of the growing elderly population, many CNAs will be needed to care for these patients. A beginning CNA can expect to earn minimum wage.
